Belgaum Fort





Kittur Fort and Palace: The fort was built by Allappa Gowda Sardesai, the ruler of the Desai dynasty between 1650 and 1681. It holds historical importance due to the Kittur, Uprising against British rule led by Rani Chennamma. The palace and fort are worth exploring to understand the region's past. Mahipalgad Fort 20 km from JNMC

Godchinamalaki Falls 40 km from JNMC
